DON'T LOOK DOWN

The 'world's scariest footpath', the Caminito del Rey (above), will reopen in early 2015. The vertigo-inducing 1.2km trail, in the narrow Gaitanes Gorge in southern Spain, has undergone a multimillion restoration to make it safer after a series of fatalities. The trail now has new metal parts to replace those that have fallen into the Guadalhorce river below. Concrete paths will replace wooden ones and handrails have been added. The trail will be free to visitors for three months and then there will be a currently undisclosed charge for tourists.
